

Padua College Uniform Policy Regulations

Please note that winter uniform must be worn from 1 May to 31 August. Summer or winter uniforms may be worn on all other dates.

BLAZER	• Must be worn to and from school throughout the year. • Must be the outer garment, except on days as determined by the College. • Must be worn for all formal Padua College occasions.
SUMMER UNIFORM	• Padua College summer dress (to the knees) or Padua College grey shorts or pants (to the ankle). • Black leather belt - plain buckle (optional). • Padua College white (short or long sleeved) shirt. • Navy blue short or knee-high socks. • Black leather lace-up or T-bar school shoes. No soft or suede or boots. Skate shoes are not permitted. Shoes must be done up at all times. • Navy blue Padua College jumper (optional). • Padua College blue blazer (Years 7-9); with piping on lapel (Years 10 - 12). • Wide brimmed Padua College hat or cap.
WINTER UNIFORM	• Padua College winter skirt (mid-calf length) or Padua College grey shorts or pants (to the ankle). • Padua College tie is optional with the skirt; compulsory with grey shorts or pants. • Black leather belt - plain buckle (optional). • Padua College white (short or long sleeved) shirt (must be tucked in when wearing a tie). • Navy blue socks or navy-blue tights. • Black leather lace-up or T-bar school shoes. No soft or suede or boots. Skate shoes are not permitted. Shoes must be done up at all times. • Navy Blue Padua College jumper (optional). • Padua College blue blazer (Years 7-9); with piping on lapel (Years 10 - 12). • Blue, white or cream Padua College scarf or gloves (optional). • Padua College soft shell jacket (optional).
SPORTS UNIFORM	• Sports uniform is worn for all Physical Education classes and events. Students in Years 7 – 12 may wear the sports uniform to school on days when they have a scheduled Physical Education practical class. • Padua College rugby jumper or Padua College soft shell jacket may be worn with the sports uniform. • Padua College sport polo shirt and House polo shirt. • Padua College navy shorts • Padua College sport socks or predominantly white socks. • Padua College navy blue track pants – optional. • Lace up Sports shoes. • To comply with OH&S, canvas shoes must not be worn.
HAT	• Padua College hat or cap is compulsory during outdoor classes in Terms 1 & 4 and encouraged during break times.
ACCESSORIES	• School bag - College issued backpack. • Only Padua College issued badges may be worn. • No additions are permitted with the uniform e.g. Visible T-Shirts, bike shorts, jackets, tights, skins etc.
JEWELLERY & MAKE UP	• A maximum of two earrings per ear in the ear lobe (small studs or sleepers). Clear plastic studs and band aids to cover piercings are not permitted. • Students are permitted to wear a small Christian religious pendant, crucifix, or small cross on a fine chain, it should be worn underneath the student's shirt or dress. Excess jewelry will be confiscated. • Make up is to be kept to a minimum and must be natural looking. • Clear nail polish is permitted.
HAIR	• Hair is to be clean and tidy. Hair need only to be tied back in circumstances/classes as an OHS requirement. • Hair ribbons must be in Padua College or House colours. • Extremes in hair cut or styles are not permitted. Number 2 haircut is the minimum. • Hair may be dyed in one natural hair shade. • All students must be clean shaven.
UNIFORM EXEMPTIONS	• If a student is not able to adhere to the Uniform Policy, the parents/guardians should contact the House- Coordinator for a Uniform Pass to be issued.
