In case of illness, a medical certificate must be handed to senior admin upon return to school. Failure to complete the task will (on most occasions) result in a ZERO grade being awarded.

Students will be given written notice by their subject teacher regarding any alterations to the above schedule. Notification will also be emailed through to parents in the case of Units 3 & 4 subjects.

Students absent on the day of a SAT task due date must make arrangements to have the task delivered to school before the closing time stipulated by the teacher

Any student who has outstanding SAC/s or has not achieved an S for the given outcome/unit will be required to complete these/additional work prior to the last day of Year 11 classes.
